YMCA SCHOOL-AGE CHILD CARE PROGRAMS... This program is designed to provide children of working parents or students with quality before and after school care in a healthy and caring environment. The staff's goal is to make children feel good about their accomplishments through positive interaction. The staff/child ratio is maintained at one staff per 14 children or less.

PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

May include any or all of the following:

- arts and crafts
- daily snack (afternoon only)
- imagination stations
- gym/group games
- community service projects
- character development
- special events
- interest areas
- outdoor activities
- enrichment programs

PROGRAM SCHEDULE

- Conducted on every regular school day.
- Coordinates with scheduled late starts and early school dismissals (conferences, inservices, etc...) for the majority of schools. (non-refundable fee per child)
 - Late Start-\$5.00
 - Early Dismissal-\$7.50
- When school is cancelled due to snow YMCA programs are CANCELLED. (This includes full days as well as partial days.) No refunds will be given.
- Kid's Day Out™ Program is available on no school days. A Kid's Day Out Program registration form will be mailed to people registered for the 2011-12 Before/After School Programs (Registration in September on a first come-first served basis).

REGISTRATION AND CANCELLATION INFO

- Registration will be held at three different times. Please refer to the back cover for information on which registration kick off date applies to you. Registration is taken on a first come, first served basis.
- Register now to secure your child's spot for the 2011-12 school year. (Space is limited at each site and may fill quickly.) Please note: Past participants **are not** automatically enrolled in the program –you will **need** to register. Wait lists exist for current school year only.
- A minimum of 12 children is required to operate any Before or After School Program.
- There is a registration fee of \$25 per child for Before and/or After School. This is a one time, annual, non-refundable fee for all participants.
- Your registration will be accepted **only** if:
 1. A \$25 non-refundable registration fee per child is included.
 2. Your enrollment form is **completely** filled out.
 3. A completed school year "Draft Agreement" is included.
 4. Your YMCA program fees are paid up to date.
- Confirmation of your registration will be mailed to you. More detailed program information will be mailed prior to start of program.
- If you wish to cancel before the program start date, a written, two-week notice must be received by the SACC office to relieve you of further payment.
- If you wish to cancel after the program start date, written notice must be on file in the SACC office two weeks in advance. Parents are responsible for all program fees during this two week period, whether or not the child participates in the program.

- There is a \$3 discount for a 2nd or 3rd child.
- Your child(ren) may attend one or two days per week, but you must pay the minimum of three days per week.
- Parents with varied schedules may choose the number of days you child(ren) will attend each week, but your payment will remain constant. For example: a child attending three days one week and four days the next week will always pay a four day rate.

PAYMENT POLICIES

- Child care payment options will include bank draft or credit card draft. No cash or checks will be accepted. Monthly drafts can be taken out on the 1st or 15th of the month per your request.
- It is imperative that childcare fees are paid on time. If you fall behind, childcare may be terminated and children on waiting lists will be called. A telephone call will be made to you before any action is taken. This will be strictly enforced.
- 3, 4 or 5 day permanent schedules
Parents are not charged for all regularly scheduled school days off (i.e. Christmas, teachers convention, inservices, etc.) Fees will reflect actual school days scheduled.
- 4 day varied schedules
There is no charge for all regularly scheduled school days off. Fees will reflect the minimum of 3 days or the usual 4 day rate.
- 3 day varied schedules
You will always be charged the minimum 3 day weekly rate with the exception of any full weeks off (i.e. Spring Break, Easter and/or Christmas).
- Financial assistance available - to receive an application check appropriate box on the registration form.
