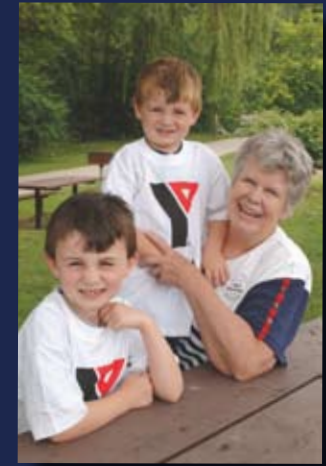

Assistants must satisfactorily complete ten hours of training in the care of school-age children within three to six months of hire. The YMCA will provide this training.

Substitutes:

Must meet the requirements of an assistant and be available on short notice.
