ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Full Circle Summer Camp at the Greater Green Bay YMCA is an inclusive summer day camp designed to help every child thrive. Offered at both the East and West YMCA locations, Full Circle provides a supportive and enriching environment where campers are encouraged to explore their strengths, build confidence, and create meaningful friendships.

This program serves children ages 7 to 15 who are neurodivergent, including but not limited to autism, ADHD, Down syndrome, sensory processing differences, anxiety, bipolar disorder, and developmental delays. Our experienced staff create a safe, engaging space where campers can learn, play, and grow while feeling valued and supported every step of the way.

Full day camp runs from 9:00am-4:00pm Monday-Friday

Half day camp runs from 9:00am- 12:00pm Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.

DROP OFF

Drop off may start at 8:45am, please drop the participants off to their respective camp rooms inside the YMCA.

Children must be dropped off and picked up directly at the location they are signed up for as there is no transportation to and from camp.

Half day pick up may start at 11:45AM

Full day pick up may start at 3:45PM
