SCHEDULE

- ▶ Operates every regular school day
- ▶ Coordinates with scheduled early dismissals (conferences, inservices, etc.) for the majority of schools.

Early Dismissal - \$8.00

- ▶ When schools are canceled for weather-related events, YMCA School-Age programs are also CANCELED. No refunds are given.
- ▶ Kid's Day Out program is available on scheduled no-school days. A registration form will be sent to those registered for the 2025-26 Before/After School Programs (registration in September on a first-come, first-served basis).

- ▶ There is a \$3 discount for a 2nd or 3rd child.
- ▶ Your child(ren) may attend one or two days per week, but you must pay the minimum of three days per week.
- ▶ Parents with varied schedules may choose the number of days your child(ren) will attend each week, but your payment will remain constant. For example: a child attending three days one week and four days the next week will always pay a four day rate.

- Children attending HOWARD, MEADOWBROOK and LINEVILLE must call Lamers to receive a "Special Request for Transportation" form. There is no additional transportation fee for this service if you live within the district.
- Children attending CORMIER and PIONEER will ride a Lamers bus, arranged by the Green Bay YMCA. There is no additional transportation fee for this service if you live within the district.

AFTER SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION

- Children attending HOWARD, MEADOWBROOK and LINEVILLE must call Lamers to receive a "Special Request for Transportation" form. There is no additional transportation fee for this service if you live within the district.
- Children attending CORMIER will be transported to the Valley View program. This transportation has already been arranged and there is no additional transportation fee for this service if you live within the district.
- Children attending BAY HARBOR, FOREST GLEN, ST. JOHN the BAPTIST, SUAMICO: Cooperative busing is provided by Lamers for the After School Program through existing bus routes. Seats are on a space available basis and at reasonable rates. Call Lamers to make your arrangements.
- Children attending KENNEDY, KING and MACARTHUR must call Green Bay Schools to complete a transportation contract (transportation fees apply).

REGISTRATION KICK-OFF DATES FOR 2025-2026 BEFORE AND/OR AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Register at Ferguson Family Y ONLY

Register now to secure your child's spot for the 2025-26 school year. (Space is limited at each site and may fill quickly.) Please note: Past participants are not automatically enrolled in the program – you will need to register. Wait lists exist for current school year only. Registrations will be taken at the Ferguson Family YMCA. Registration forms can be dropped off at the Ferguson Family Y SACC office as well as mailed (235 North Jefferson Street), or emailed (sacc@greenbayymca.org). All registration dates will be held in a lottery fashion and conducted by YMCA staff within the school-age office. There will be NO IN-PERSON registration process conducted. All registration forms must be received in the SACC office prior to the actual registration date for which you qualify (see registration dates below). If your form is not received prior to the date, it will be looked at on the following day received.

Thursday, April 10

Y members (prior to 3/13/25) who are current (2024-25) before/after school participants.

Sunday, April 13

Y members (prior to 3/13/25) who are NOT current (2024–25) before/after school participants; General Public who are current (2024–25) before/after school participants.

Tuesday, April 15

General Public

Confirmation of your registration will be e-mailed to you. More detailed program information will be e-mailed prior to start of program.

>> CANCELLATION INFO

- 1. If you wish to cancel <u>before</u> the program start date, a written, two-week notice must be received by the School-Age Child Care (SACC) office to relieve you of further payment.
- 2. If you wish to cancel <u>after</u> the program start date, a written notice must be on file in the SACC office two weeks in advance. Parents are responsible for all program fees during this 2-week period, whether or not the child participates in the program.
